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Regulations regarding admission to the Degree courses

1. Admission

Admission is open to all citizens of India. Foreign students, however, will be admitted on special grounds.

2. Qualification

A pass in the Plus Two examination or its equivalent with a minimum of D+ Grade is the qualification to apply for admission to the course.

3. Constitution of the Examination Board

The Vice Chancellor will constitute an Examination Board with the Registrar as Chairman and the head of the department concerned and one external expert as member to evaluate the artistic aptitude of applicants seeking admission to the Degree course.

The Board will evaluate the practical knowledge and artistic inclination of the applicant and will give, after the examination, an opportunity to him/her to reflect on his/her performance at the time of interview. Applicants will be ranked on the basis of the marks thus awarded to them.

The Vice Chancellor will be the final authority to dispose the complaints, if any in this regard. He can either assess the situation on his own or, if found necessary, can appoint a committee of experts for re-evaluation.

4. Age

The applicant should not have completed 23 years of age on the first day of June of the academic year in which admission is sought.

5. Name of the course

Duration of the course is three year divided into six semesters. The duration of each semester shall be 90 working days. There will be an examination at the end of each semester. B.A. Degree will be awarded to those who pass all the examinations.

10. Procedure of selection

The applicants will be ranked on the basis of marks obtained by them in the practical examination and admission will be made on the basis of seniority in the rank list.

11. Reservation

Rules of reservations prescribed by the State and Central Governments will be followed in all the admission procedures.

12. Fee

Candidates selected for admission have to remit the fee prescribed by the University from time to time.

13. Hostel

The students admitted to the course shall stay in the campus hostel. They can leave the campus only with the permission of the guardian/local guardian. Guardians should give an undertaking, at the time of admission, to the effect that their wards will obey the rules and regulations prescribed by the University from time to time.

14. Weightage

A Weightage of 10% of marks acquired in the interview will be given to those who have passed in the subjects (optional) concerned in Plus Two level.

Tuition fee for a year can be remitted in one instalment or in two equal installments; the first instalment is to be paid at the time of admission and the second instalment at the beginning of the second semester. SC\ST\OEC candidates will be given exemption from payment of Tuition fee, Special fee and Examination fee, subject to the sanction of concession by the Department concerned of the Government of Kerala. However, they will have to remit all other fees. They may also submit application for fee-concession in the prescribed form.

III. Fee

IV. Instruction to Candidates

1. Applicants are advised to read the instructions carefully before filling up the application form. All the columns should be filled up.
2. Separate application form shall be used for each course.

3. Incomplete and late applications will be rejected.
4. Admission schedule is given in the prospectus. Individual intimations will not be made unless there is a change. Candidates are advised to keep in touch with the office/HOD regarding the process of admission.
5. Prescribed fee shall be remitted at the time of admission. Fee once remitted will not be refunded.
6. Candidates claiming reservations, fee concession etc. should produce documentary evidence to support the claim.
7. Complaints, if any, may be lodged with the Vice-Chancellor at least two days prior to the date fixed for admission.
8. Students shall be accompanied by their parents at the time of admission.
9. Original documents should not be attached to the application form. The following documents have to be presented at the time of interview.
