

MASTERS OF ARTS Post Graduate Program (CBCSS) 2020-22

Regulations regarding admission to the Post Graduate courses

1. Admission

Admission is open to all citizens of India. Foreign students, however, will be admitted on special grounds.

2. Qualification

A minimum of 'C+' Grade under CBCSS or 45% marks in Degree examination or equalent Degree in the subject concerned recognized by the Universities in Kerala are eligible for Admission. In the absence of eligible candidates those who have undergone practice in concerned subject through traditional method and shown his/her efficiency in the subject also will be considered depending on the basis of certificates form accredited agencies/institution, competition at district/state/national level and performance in the test and interview and recommendation by the admission committee consisting of Head of Department.

3. Constitution of the Interview Board

The Vice Chancellor will constitute an Interview Board. The head of the department concerned and one external expert as member to evaluate the artistic aptitude of applicants seeking admission to the M.A. Degree course.

The Board will evaluate the practical knowledge and artistic inclination of the applicant and will give, after the interview, an opportunity to him/her to reflect on his/her performance at the time of interview. Applicants will be ranked on the basis of the marks thus awarded to them.

The Vice Chancellor will be the final authority to dispose the complaints, if any in this regard. He can either assess the situation on his own or, if found necessary, can appoint a committee of experts for re-evaluation.

4. Age

The applicant should not have completed 28 years of age on the first day of June of the academic year in which admission is sought.

5. Name of the course

Duration of the course is two year divided into four semesters. The duration of each semester shall be 90 working days. There will be an examination at the end of each semester. M.A. Degree will be awarded to those who pass all the examinations.

6. Grading system based on 5 point scale as given below:

8. Procedure of selection

The applicants will be ranked on the basis of marks obtained by them in the practical examination and admission will be made on the basis of seniority in the rank list.

9. Reservation

Rules of reservations prescribed by the State and Central Governments will be followed in all the admission procedures.

10. Fee

Candidates selected for admission have to remit the fee prescribed by the University from time to time.

11. Hostel

- 1. Admission to the hostel is subject to the availability of the accommodation facility.
- 2. If the students admitted in the hostel, they can leave the campus only with the permission of the guardian/local guardian. Guardians should give an undertaking, at the time of admission, to the effect that their wards will obey the rules and regulations prescribed by the University from time to time.

12. Marks for the Interview will be calculated as shown below:

a. Interview 70 Marks
b. *Weightage for Degree in the Concerned subject 25 Marks
c. NCC/NSS 5 Marks
Total 100 Marks

Tuition fee for a year can be remitted in one instalment or in two equal installments; the first instalment is to be paid at the time of admission and the second instalment at the beginning of the second semester. SC\ST candidates will be given exemption from payment of Tuition fee, Special fee and Examination fee, subject to the sanction of concession by the Department concerned of the Government of Kerala. However, they will have to remit all other fees. They may also submit application for fee-concession in the prescribed form.

III. Fee

IV. Instruction to Candidates

- 1. Applicants are advised to read the instructions carefully before filling up the application form. All the columns should be filled up.
- 2. Separate application form shall be used for each course.
- 3. Incomplete and late applications will be rejected.
- 4. Admission schedule is given in the prospectus. Individual intimations will not be made unless there is a change. Candidates are advised to keep in touch with the office regarding the process of admission.
- 5. Prescribed fee shall be remitted at the time of admission. Fee once remitted will not be refunded.
- 6. Candidates claiming reservations, fee concession etc. should produce documentary evidence to support the claim.
- 7. Complaints, if any, may be lodged with the Vice-Chancellor at least two days prior to the date fixed for admission.
- 8. Students shall be accompanied by their parents at the time of admission.
- 9. Candidates from other Universities will have to produce Migration certificate with in one month.
- 10. Original documents should not be attached to the application form. The following documents have to be presented at the time of interview.

 - b. B.A. Marklists and B.A. Certificate
- 11. The following documents have to be presented at the time of admission.
